

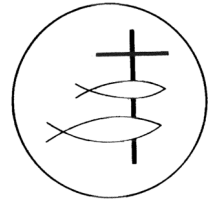
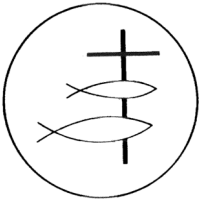

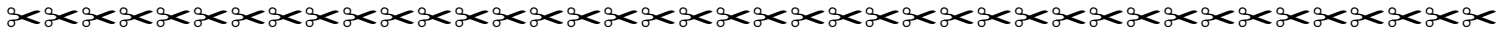
### ***Presenting Team from St. Dominic Parish***
